

The Power of the Learning Coach

- Monitoring your student login daily pace with the course schedule
- Guiding students through their lessons as needed
- Assisting with understanding the concepts being taught
- Overseeing the submission of assignments
- Ensuring fidelity in completion of assignments and assessments
- Communicating with the teacher as needed

Whether it's a parent, family member, or other adult, the learning coach is an important element contributing to your student's success.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

When and where do I get my device if I don't already have one?

Tip: To ensure that your student is on pace, be sure to print/screenshot the weekly plan on Monday and ensure that all assignments are done by the end of the week.

If you skip a day of school or a lesson in a subject, that lesson moves to the next day. All subsequent lessons also move a day forward. If you are not aware of this process, you can quickly become behind in pace.

Example: Monday - student is sick - no lessons are done. On Tuesday, the student should complete all lessons for Tuesday and Wednesday. This will keep the student on-pace.



Where Are The Grades?

Grades shown in the OLS reflect quizzes and assignments submitted to the teacher.

Progress report grades will reflect the percentage of expected progress. This calculation comes from the Actual Progress divided by the Expected Progress.
